"Iron man" Kart Championship regulations 2010

In 2010 Stockton & DMC will run a 6 round, 1 hour "Iron man" kart series, the best five of each driver's scores will count towards the overall standings. The first round will be held on Sunday January 31st 2010 followed by March 7th, April 25th, June 20th, October 3rd and November 21st.

Unregistered drivers will not be accounted for in the scores, therefore if the highest registered entrant finishes 3rd they will be classified with the full points total

Points will be scored grand prix style. I.e.; 10 for first, 8, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, and 1 point for 8th place. There shall be a maximum of 40 drivers per race and a minimum of 16. If less than 16 kart racers are entered then the event may be cancelled.

There will also be 3 bonus points for the driver on pole position at each race, 2 points for 2nd on the grid and 1 bonus point for third. An additional 1 point will be awarded for the fastest lap set during the race.

The series will run in 2 classes* split by weight at 89.0kg or 14.0 stones (196 lbs). Class A under 14.0 stones, Class B over 14.0 stones. Drivers weight must be declared prior to each race and spot checks will be made throughout the season to ensure fairness of competition.

*(subject to a minimum of 3 registered contenders per class, if less than 3 entries there shall be only one class with no weight restrictions)

Drivers in the higher weight class (class B) will also achieve 3, 2 and 1 bonus points for setting the fastest qualifying time in that division even if it is not the actual overall pole position. The same rule applies for the fastest racing lap in that class.

All 6 races will be at Teesside Autodrome, all races will be held on Sunday afternoons. There may be one or more races during the season on the shorter circuit (1300m).

There is no series registration fee, but to be eligible for the championship and to score points, racers must be members of Stockton & DMC, (for which there is a once yearly membership payment of £10, please make cheques payable to Stockton and

DMC). Racers who do not wish to compete in the championship need not pay the club membership, but may compete as normal without registering a point score.

Registered championship contenders will have their places reserved until 14 days before the event, after that time places will be offered on a first come first served basis.

A non refundable deposit of £10 per person is required no later than 14 days before the event. With no exceptions, entry will not be finalised until deposit is paid.

The entry fee will be £50 per person/kart/ race but these are subject to change depending on circuit hire costs and circuit used.
